The Lord is my shepherd I shall not want - Psalms 23:1

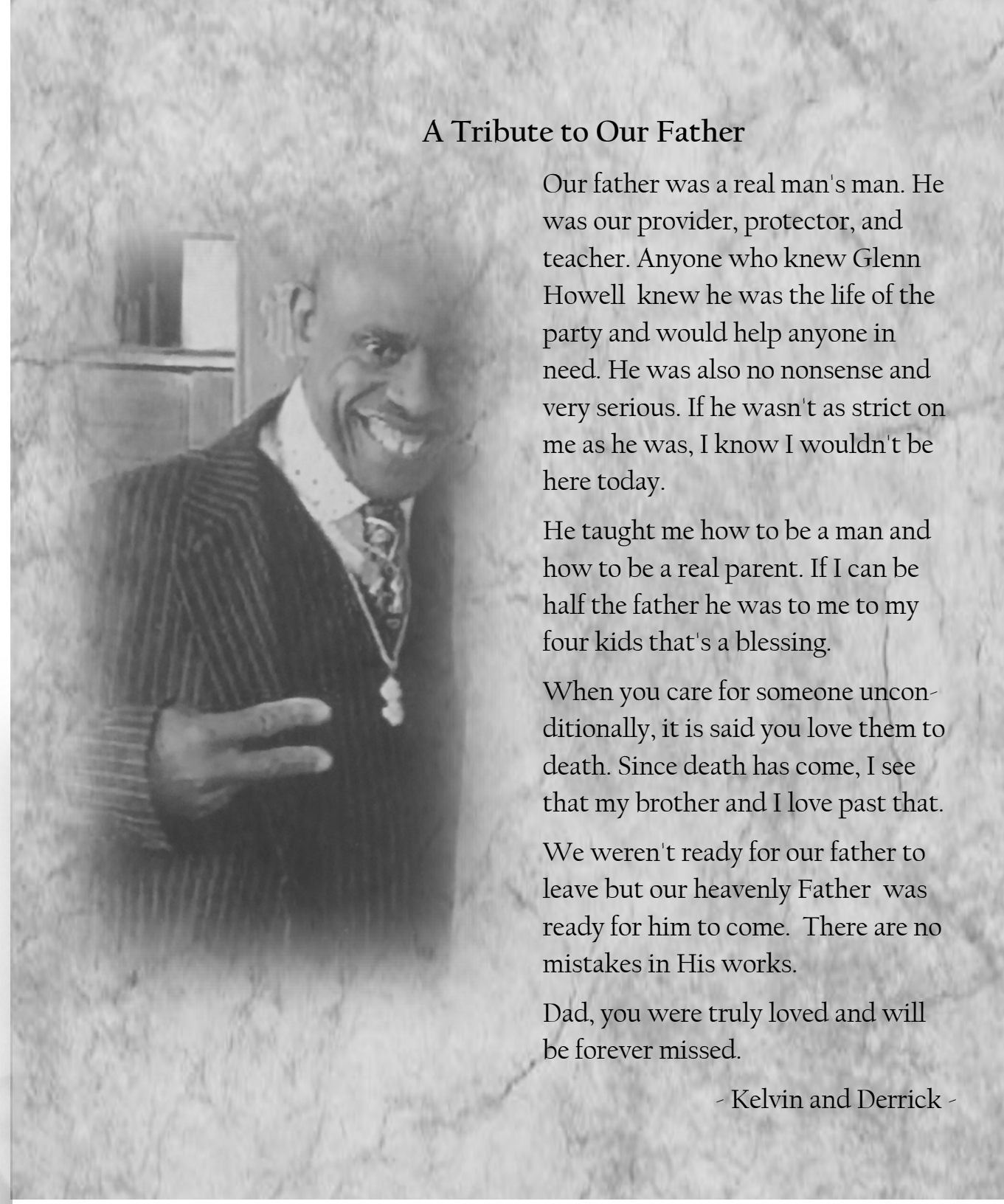
A child of God was called and he answered on October 7, 2016. He is gone from us but resting with the Lord.
