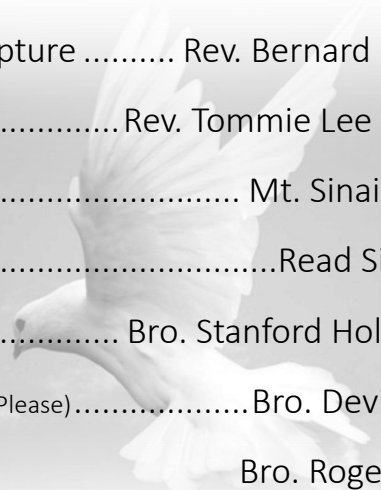

you are always on our side.*

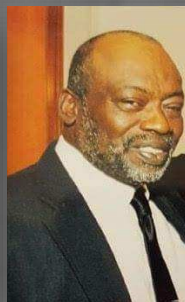
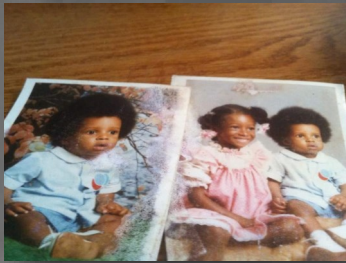
