Obituary

Mrs. Lura Dell Taylor was born August 3, 1934 in Camp Hill, Alabama to the late Arthur Tinsley and Ozella Tinsley. Affectionately known as "Baby Doll", she lived an incredible and fulfilling life. She accepted Christ at a very early age and was baptized at New Canaan Missionary Baptist Church where she was an active member for twenty years.

Lura attended grade school in Alabama and graduated from what was at that time a one room school, known as Edward Bell High School. After a brief enrollment at Alabama State University in Montgomery, AL she met and married Rev. Jesse James Taylor on May 5, 1958. Following their union they relocated to Oxnard, CA on November 8, 1958 where her husband served as an active member of the United States Air Force. With new hopes and new dreams they founded the New Progressive Missionary Baptist Church in 1963.

Lura continued her pursuit to become an educator and received an Associates of Arts Degree from Ventura College, a Bachelor of Arts Degree from California State University at Northridge and a Masters of Arts Degree in Education at Azusa Pacific University. Lura was an educator with the Oxnard Unified School District for 30 years and taught many different subjects including English, Creative Writing and Home Economics.

Singing songs of Zion was her life. Her angelic yet powerful voice was well known throughout the city. She was an artistic soloist and dedicated member of the Progressive Aires and the New Progressive Choir. Some of her favorite songs to sing include "I Am a Living Testimony", "Poor Pilgrim of Sorrow", "Elijah Rock", "Soon I Will Be Done" and "Surely God is Able". Lura was devoted to the church ministry as a whole and served as a Sunday School Teacher and she held leadership roles in the following departments: Missions & Matrons Department, Music Department, Visitation Ministry, Outreach Ministry and mentor to the youth and young adult. She was a major financial contributor to the life of the church. There was nothing she would not do to support the church and the people she loved.
