You will be completely at rest under God's silvery moon.

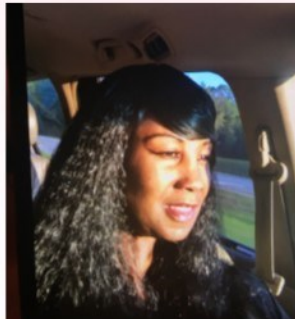
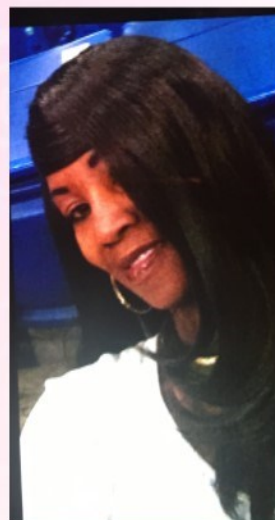
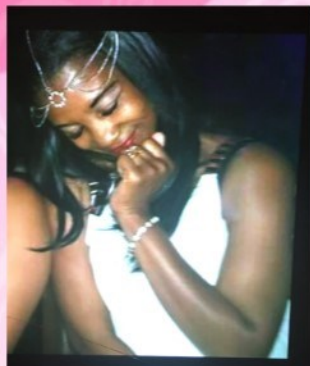
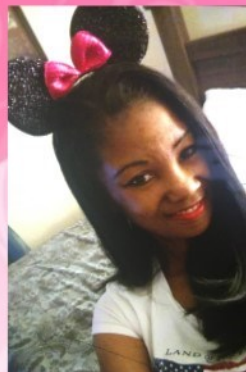
